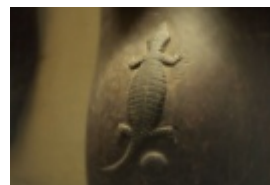

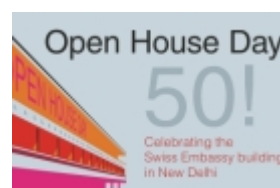
Sound Reasons 2013, sound art, contemporary Jazz and electronic music
