

Mingalar bar, salam-a-lekum and ayubowan to our audiences in Mandalay, Dhaka and Colombo!

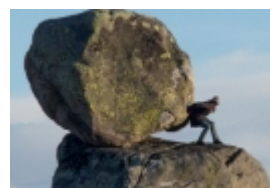
