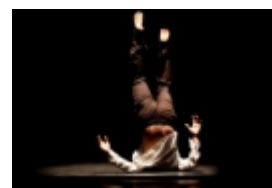
Adam Szymczyk at Speaker's Forum at the India Art Fair 2015
