

Continuing Sound Reasons, a festival of contemporary sound art and music, Pro Helvetia New Delhi in collaboration with Dr Bhau Daji Lad Museum presents ZIMOUN's sound sculpture in Mumbai this November.

Known for his conceptual and contextual understanding of sound art, ZIMOUN's sound sculptures, sound architectures and installation art, combine raw, industrial materials such as cardboard boxes, plastic bags, or old furniture, with mechanical elements such as dc-motors, wires, microphones, speakers and ventilators.

The sound sculpture on display - 80 prepared dc-motors, cotton balls, cardboard boxes - creates a dialogue with the surrounding space. Dr Bhau Daji Lad Museum offers the beautiful Special Projects Space where the core concept of Zimoun's artwork has been assembled so that it is aesthetically perceived. Do visit the museum and experience the sculpture.

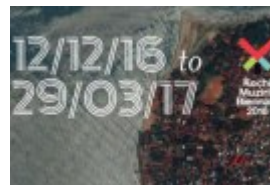
Swiss band HELY to play in Delhi, Pune, Goa and Kolkata
