

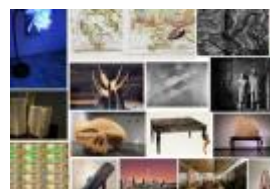

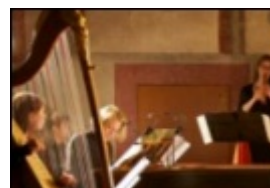
meters behind sea level, 2005/2011

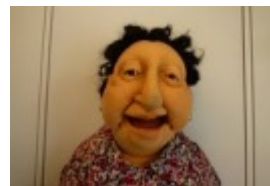
Chittrakatha'11 invites Rolf Baechler
